November is Lung Cancer Awareness Month. Anyone can get lung cancer. Lung cancer occurs when cells in the lung mutate or change. The farm to school highlight this month is the **sweet potato**. Sweet potatoes are high in fiber, fat free, and a good source of vitamins A, C and B6.

With Thanksgiving coming up here is a Sweet potato Pie recipe to share with everyone from www.allrecipes.com.



Sweet Potato Pie

Ingredients:

1 (1 pound) sweet potato	1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg
1/2 cup butter, softened	1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
1 cup white sugar	1 teaspoon vanilla extract
1/2 cup milk	1 (9-inch) unbaked pie crust

Directions:

1. Boil sweet potato whole in skin for 40 to 50 minutes, or until done. Run cold water over the sweet potato, and remove the skin.
2. Break apart sweet potato in a bowl. Add butter, and mix well with mixer. Stir in sugar, milk, eggs, nutmeg, cinnamon and vanilla. Beat on medium speed until mixture is smooth. Pour filling into an unbaked pie crust.
3. Bake at 350 degrees F (175 degrees C) for 55 to 60 minutes, or until knife inserted in center comes out clean. Pie will puff up like a souffle, and then will sink down as it cools.
