Health and Wellness

MARCH

March is National nutrition month. National Nutrition Month® is an annual campaign created by the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics. During the month of March, we invite everyone to focus on the importance of making informed food choices, developing sound eating and physical activity habits. Eat Right Bite by Bite, the campaigns slogan, is focusing on using small goals and changes in daily nutrition to create a cumulative health effect. The farm to school vegetable of the month is the carrot. The carrot is a root vegetable that is usually orange in color but can be purple, red white, yellow or even black. It is a good source of alpha and beta carotene, vitamins K and B6. Carrots can be eaten raw, cooked, steamed or

pressed for juice. They can also be used in soups, stews and even muffins and cakes. Here is a recipe from www.allrecipes.com for carrot cake muffins.

Carrot Cake Muffins

1 cup milk	1 tablespoon baking powder
2 eggs	1 1/2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
2 tablespoons applesauce, or more as needed	1/2 teaspoon salt
1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla extract	1 cup shredded carrots
2 cups all-purpose flour	6 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted and cooled
2/3 cup white sugar	

Directions

1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees F (190 degrees C). Grease 12 muffin cups or line with paper muffin liners.
2. Beat milk, eggs, applesauce, and vanilla extract together in a bowl. Whisk flour, sugar, baking powder, cinnamon, and salt together in another bowl. Stir carrots into flour mixture; fold in milk mixture and butter until batter is just combined. Spoon batter into prepared muffin cups.
3. Bake in the preheated oven until a toothpick inserted into the center of a muffin comes out clean, 18 to 20 minutes. Cool in the pan for 5 minutes before removing to a wire rack to cool completely.
