Morning Car Rider Drop Off:

Car riders drop off (in the circle) begins at 7:10 AM and ends at 8:00 AM sharp. Staff members and patrols will come inside at 8:00 AM. Students are tardy if they are not in their classrooms at 8:00 AM when the school day starts. Parents will need to walk inside the building with their students and sign their students in the front office after 8:00 AM. Homeroom begins at 7:45 AM.

Reminders:

- Students may enter the building through the carpool circle door or the front door between 7:15-8:00 AM.
- Parents and visitors can only enter the building through the front door and must sign in with the front office.
- Student may not enter a trailer from the parking lot, students must come through the building so we can walk them to class.
- Tardy students must be walked in by an adult and signed in at the front office. Students are tardy if they are not in classroom by 8:00 AM.

Absences:

Please communicate with the homeroom teacher when your student is absent. Also, send any attendance excuses or doctor's notes to LivseyAttendanceRequest@dekalbschoolsga.org for the registrar. You may include teacher and registrar on same email for convenience.

DCSD Excused Absences Policy:

Excused absences are defined by law and in the rules of the Georgia Board of Education. Students enrolled in the District shall be excused from attending school in the following circumstances:

- Personal illness;
- Death or illness in the immediate family;
- Religious holidays;
- Instances where attendance by the student will be hazardous;
- Tests and physical exams for military service and the National Guard;
- Students eligible to vote in a public election may be allowed no more than one day for registering to vote or voting in a public election; or
- A student whose parent or legal guardian serving in the U.S. military may be allowed up to five days per school year to visit with the parent or legal guardian either prior to the parent or legal guardian's deployment or while the parent or guardian is on leave from deployment.

Attendance:

Please commit to making sure your child attends school every day possible this year. The evidence is clear: children with good attendance are more likely to be successful in school. Every day counts. Missing school even 10% of the time has a significant negative impact on reading and math achievement as children progress through school. Thank you for all you do to support your child's school success and well-being, as well as our school.

Lost and Found:

If your child is missing a coat, jacket, shirt, lunchbox, etc., stop by and check out the lost and found (located near the Media Center). Please write your student's name in jackets, coats, and water bottles.


